New Non Operative Treatment for Dupuytren's Contracture of the Hand

Many patients develop permanent contractures of their fingers associated with a band or "cord" of scar tissue in their palms. This is called Dupuytren's disease and is usually treated with a straightforward surgical removal of the cord. XIAFLEX has been introduced as the first nonsurgical option in patients with a palpable cord. The enzyme in XIAFLEX weakens the cord, so that it can be released manually 24 hours later without surgery. This may require more than one injection session and there is some post injection swelling and discomfort. This procedure may be an alternative to surgery.

Aging Eyes – The First Sign of Aging

The first sign of aging in most people is either some slight wrinkling of the skin around the outer edges of the eyes or some loose skin of the upper eyelids. Botox or Dysport will usually solve the slight wrinkles, while upper eyelid surgery is needed to solve the loose skin of the upper eyelid. People often ask, "When should I have my upper lids done?" The answer is, "It should only have to be done once; when it bothers you enough, you should do it! That way you can enjoy the results longer." Eyelid surgery is done as outpatient surgery and most patients are up taking care of themselves the next day. Sutures are out in five days and most people are back to their normal lives in five to ten days.



When Do I Need a Browlift?

Some individuals have just a little sagging or heaviness on the outer edges of their eyebrows. We can solve this with a brow tacking procedure under local anesthesia.
