The Halo treatment is the world's first hybrid laser. It is the first laser to utilize two wavelengths to treat the epidermis and dermis (upper and lower) part of the skin simultaneously. Over time, your skin can lose its youthful glow due to sun exposure and your body's natural aging process. As a result, your body may develop sun-spots, fine lines, and lose that natural healthy glow. Previous lasers couldn't effectively remove this damage because the treatment was either too shallow or too deep. Halo eliminates years of damage by precisely targeting the right depth. 
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A more intense treatment will give your skin that youthful glow with just a few days of downtime. Advantages include:

Halo is different than BBL because it treats at a deeper level, a repair treatment as evident by the UV photos. It fits right in between BBL & Resurfacing, combining the best of both worlds with minimal downtime.

Contour TRL

Sciton has perfected skin resurfacing. Treatments can range from superficial like the **NanoLaserPeel** (which might be appropriate for eliminating fine lines and tired-looking skin) to medium depth like **MicroLaserPeel** (appropriate for light to medium wrinkles and sun damage) to **Deep Resurfacing** (which is often used to drastically improve skin tone/texture and eliminate deep wrinkles.)

NanoLaserPeelTM

Nothing shows age like our skin. If your skin looks dull and tired, you may be considering (or already doing) treatments like a chemical peel or microdermabrasion. These are treatments that use chemicals or abrasive materials to remove the top layer of the skin, revealing new skin underneath.

But the NanoLaserPeel from Sciton can do much more. It uses light energy to instantly remove the top layers of the skin at a depth that also accelerates the skin's own renewal process by activating special messenger proteins. Microdermabrasion and chemical peels often

don't get deep enough and other lasers leaves a layer of heat-damaged cells that interrupt the ability of these messenger cells to communicate with deep layers of skin. Only the NanoLaser-Peel from Sciton has the precision to work at just the right depth, creating beautifully smooth, luminous

A MicroLaserPeel removes a thin layer of damaged epidermis to improve texture and provide a more youthful appearance. It provides superior results because it gently revitalizes the entire surface of the skin. The procedure is performed in your physician's office and can be custom tailored to your specific skin condition and desired downtime.

The MicroLaserPeel's beam is scanned over a treatment area to remove a very thin layer of the skin. Removing the top layer eliminates




some of the damaged cells that can give skin a tired, aged look. As the skin heals, fresh cells grow and resurface the treated area. The result is healthier-looking skin, often with reduced wrinkles and improved color evenness. Patients often say that it looks like their skin went from looking tired to vibrant. Average Downtime 3-7 days.

Contour TRL - Deep ResurfacingTM

Contour TRL safely removes a deeper layer of skin to a depth determined by your physician. The depth of treatment will depend on the skin condition, your desired outcome and expectation for downtime. Because Contour TRL can affect tissue with micron precision, your physician can treat your skin with the exact amount of energy needed — no more, no less.

Treating skin with a laser stimulates the growth of new collagen, which improves the skin's thickness and resilience. The skin surface will also re-grow with fresh, healthy cells, which will give your skin a younger rejuvenated appearance. Average Downtime 7-10 days.


If you are aware of the fact that The Georgia Institute For Plastic Surgery offers skincare and makeup services for our patients (and has for nearly two decades) you are in the minority!
